



## Design choices


# Wi-Fi protection

Any VPNS? In country's with censorship laws citizens must use VPNS to see the news as well as hide their searches from the government



A demonstration of the useful designs from “The Manifesto Collection” Aswell as other designs that interfere with AI scans




# Location reminder
